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DISCIPLINES:

Individual Sparring (Matsogi) (using ITF Style Only)

Individual Patterns (Tul) (using ITF Style Only)

Team Patterns (Tul) (using ITF Style Only)

One team per Taekwon-Do school, these can be colored belts, black belts, and also mixed. The team pattern competition, unlike the individual competitions, is the team performance where 3 or 5 competitors of a team enter the ring and demonstrate their teamwork. Hence, the technical movements

should be performed collectively in accordance with the general choreographic composition requirements. However, the technical aspects including fast and slow motions, continuous and connected motions should be executed as laid down in the Encyclopaedia. Scoring will not commence until the command “Shi Jak” is given by the Centre Referee.

Optional patterns and designated patterns in team competitions for Junior, Youth, Adult and Veteran Categories are shown below. In Optional Patterns for the team competitions, the Patterns should correspond to the lowest Degree degree holder.

To compete, teams may bring their own prepared pattern, and the final may be decided by a team-designated pattern. This may be done in the usual way, but in this case, synchronization will be the most important measure.

Champions Cup: Individual Power Breaking (Wi Ryok)

A single category: all ages (ages 16 and up) and black belts ranks only. (ages 16 and up)

Team Power Breaking (Wi Ryok)

Technique: Penetrating side kick with the front leg with an X step

One team per Taekwon-Do school, Only for black belts.

Teams must consist of 3 to 5 participants

All boards must be broken for each elimination technique. The competitor can begin with one ready posture and end with the same ready posture. Prejudging is optional; if a competitor does not want to do prejudging, he or she can go straight from ready stance-break. The competitor will adopt a ready posture in the form of an L- stance forearm guarding block posture. On the command from the Centre Referee the competitor



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will be given 30 seconds to execute the break attempt regardless of the number of prejudging without touching the target. When making his/her break attempt, he/she makes a ready posture and shouts “Kia!” with the forearm guarding block or a sitting ready stance posture. The breaking attempt consists of the execution of bow - ready posture – breaking – ready

DISQUALIFICATION

For the following offences, the competitor may be disqualified from the whole competition:

- Serious misconduct against umpires.
- Any competitor suspected of being under influence of alcoholic beverages or drugs.
